UCA PD Makes Arrests, Recovers Stolen Property

University of Central Arkansas, Conway, AR. –UCAPD investigators working on burglary and theft cases from the last few months have made several arrests related to those crimes and continue to recover stolen property related to these cases.

In May of 2009, two students living in Arkansas Hall reported their laptops stolen from their room. Soon afterwards, student Keith Robinson, was arrested for burglary, felony theft, and filing a false police report after investigators learned that Mr. Robinson was not a victim, but in fact the suspect who had stolen the property. The victim's \$1,400.00 laptop was recovered from the suspect's vehicle.

Around the same time as the above incident, two other reports of burglary and theft of property in Bernard Hall were reported. UCAPD investigators were able to identify three student suspects: Keith Robinson, Jahmal Calvin, and Brandon Williams. As soon as they returned for the 2009 Fall semester, all three suspects were arrested for burglary and felony theft of property. Jahmal Calvin was also charged with fraudulent use of a credit card. Over \$3,000.00 of stolen property was recovered.

On August 26, 2009, a student living in Arkansas Hall reported a black male suspect entered his room and convinced him that he was there to get the other roommate's property. The suspect took an X-Box along with six games, a television, and laptop all worth \$2,500.00. On September 9, 2009, investigators arrested student Donald Homes for burglary and theft of property in connection to the August 26 incident. Some of the stolen property was recovered at the time of Mr. Homes' arrest.

On August 30, 2009, a student's vehicle was stolen from campus. The victim's roommate, student Darrell Crawford, soon became a suspect. Darrell Crawford was arrested in Amarillo, Texas in the stolen vehicle on September 4, 2009. He has been charged for felony theft of a vehicle.

On September 4, 2009, investigators assisted the Faulkner County Sheriff's Department in recovering stolen property from a Bear Village apartment. This incident is related to an off campus theft.

On September 17, 2009 while conducting an investigation on earlier burglaries, investigators arrested, non-student Delvin Morris, for obstruction of governmental operations for giving false identification. Mr. Morris was at Stadium Park Apartments in a student's apartment. Mr. Morris also had two felony failure to appear warrants for robbery out of Monticello.
